Background Information & History

Step back in time with us for a moment, if you will, to Budapest in the 1890s

The official opening of the Grand Hotel Royal, the jewel in the crown of the newly developed Andrássy Avenue, was taking place. Budapest was in the throes of the Millennium Exhibition, and the hotel was quick to become a favourite haunt of local luminaries like Jenő Heltay, Sándor Hunyadi, Lajos Nagy, and Gyula Krúdy. With a riotous blend of state-of-theart features and contemporary glamour, the building housed a palm garden, confectioners, cellar bar and grocery store among other things (a bank, post office and hairdresser to name a few). This hub of innovation and activity even attracted the Lumiére brothers, who picked the hotel as the venue for the first screening of a motion picture in Budapest. The cinema became a permanent part of the hotel, and concertgoers were also regularly treated to performances conducted by Béla Bartók himself. In 1909, the hotel even exhibited the very first Hungarian aero plane.

Like so many grand buildings of its era, the Royal suffered during the Second World War, serving as an office building as well as a hotel. Unfortunate events continued in the 1950s and '60s, with a fire destroying most of the roof, and an extensive restoration project stripping away most of the original interior features. Even the re-opening of the cinema in 1959, now renamed the Red Star cinema, couldn't bring back the magic of that first opening.

When Corinthia re-opened the hotel in 2003, it was only after a loving, record-breaking €100 million renovation, during which restoring elegance was the top priority. Hungarian plasterwork adorns the walls, giving an unmistakable local flavor. The hotel is a monument to modern luxury, with a tasteful respect for the past evident around every corner.

Budapest a Safe City

Budapest is a beautiful city and its people are generally friendly and willing to be of assistance. Visitors to our city are also, for the most part, friendly, good-natured people. Budapest is still a safe city. However, unfortunately there are always those who take pleasure in doing ill by others – for example in a hotel, in a carpark, on public transport and on busy streets and squares. This is where car thieves and pickpockets like to strike. These people exist in Budapest too, although luckily, not to the same extent as in other major cities. But you should, nonetheless, take precautions against thieves of all kinds. This brochure offers some essential tips.

In the Hotel

Never leave your luggage unattended on the pavement in front of the hotel or in the lobby - neither when you arrive, nor when you depart.

Deposit your valuables either in the in-room guest safe or in the safe deposit box at the Concierge, both are free of charge.

Always lock your hotel room when you go out (even if you remain in the hotel, for example in the restaurant).

Never leave your handbag unattended in the breakfast room or hotel restaurant (even when you go over to the buffet table).



When Walking in the City

Normally it is not necessary for you to take your passport with you when you go sightseeing. Note down your passport number or make a photocopy of it. Keep it separately from your passport.

Do not take all your money with you when you go for a walk.

Carry your purse or wallet as close to your body as possible - preferably in an inside pocket that closes with a zipper. If you keep your purse in a handbag or shoulder bag, please make sure it is well down inside the bag.

Always keep your cheques in a separate place from your cheque card. Check regularly to make sure your cheques and card are still there. Note down the numbers of the cheques you have written and keep receipts from purchases made by credit card.

Watch out for pickpockets who may try to divert your attention. Pay attention if a stranger jostle you and ruffles your clothing. Avoid dense crowds.

If you are pushed into a crowd, turn around immediately and look to see who pushed you. By doing so you may prevent a handbag from being stolen.

Always keep your handbag or shoulder bags closed and hold it toward the front of your body so that it cannot easily be snatched away from you.

Beware of strangers giving you unsolicited assistance or directions.

If you go to a restaurant, take your wallet, camera, and other valuables with you to the table. Do not leave personal property such as driving license or keys in your coat if you leave it in the cloakroom.



Safety Tips All About Cars and Taxis

Always lock your car; never leave the key in the car. Make sure that all windows and the sunroof are closed, the boot is locked, and the lights are turned off. Do not forget to switch on the car alarm system. Our hotel offers garage space, you should use it.

Do not leave valuables in your car. Remember: Even a locked boot and a supervised garage is not a guarantee that no one will break into your car.

If the radio in your car can be easily removed from its casing, please take it with you and keep it in a safe place.

If you drink alcohol, you are not allowed to drive at all. A taxi will take you safely back to the hotel.

- Ensure the taxi is legitimate.
- No flat rates.
- Ask a local or the concierge at your hotel how much the taxi ride should cost.
- Know the local currency.
- No differentiated price between night and day.



In Case of Emergencies

If you lose your cheque card or credit card, inform your bank, credit card organization and your hotel immediately. Please also report the loss to the nearest police station.

If travel documents, your camera or other valuables are stolen, please report the theft immediately to the nearest police station. You will receive a copy of the police report, which you can use both to have replacement documents issued (Embassy or Consulate) and for insurance purposes.
