POSITION SUMMARY:

The Plant Technician will deputise in the absence of the Director of Engineering or the Assistant Maintenance Manager. He/She attends to any regular/general repair and maintenance items according to issued orders or instruction by the Director of Engineering.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensures an efficient running of the property's systems to include, but not limited to HVAC, Potable water purification systems, Effluent treatment systems, Boilers, Chillers and Pool filtration systems.
- Owns and maintains diligently operational records as necessary
- Assists with parts and asset procurement
- Keeps abreast of newest trends and innovations in the hospitality industry.
- Generally being alert for opportunities to improve the profitability of the department i.e. through controlling wastage and being responsible for the economy of all utilities and resources.
- Takes a proactive approach to Engineering activity, anticipating potential opportunities.
- Sets up and monitor PPM system.
- Carries out any specialist duties you are trained for.
- Responsible for the building management system.
- Ensures the refrigeration and air conditioning systems are fully serviced to strict guidelines.
- Maintains an asset log within the facilities management system and update when required.
- Identifies trends and action accordingly.
- Ensures that statutory inspections are carried out at the required times.
- Files hard copies of statutory examinations.



- Behaves in a quiet and polite manner at all times.
- Ensures bedrooms doors are shut when not working in them, however short the period of absence from the room.
- Assists in any way that may be necessary to ensure the efficiency and smooth running of the Maintenance and hotel.

- Reports any problems/complaints to the Director of Engineering.
- Attends any department training sessions and/or meetings required.
- Liaises with other departments to ensure good communication and offer support.
- Is fully conversant with the Corinthia Employee Handbook.
- Supports the hotel operation in times of demand.
- Drives the Corinthia values and philosophy.
- In the absence of the Director of Engineering and Assistant, to be fully responsible for all aspects within the Maintenance department.
- Supports and Covers Duty Maintenance shifts when necessary
